

THE STANDARD BANK OF SOUTH AFRICA LIMITED - DATA PRIVACY CONSENT

1. I/We _____, with Identity/Registration Number/Master's Reference Number: _____ (**Applicant**), being a supplier or service provider to a provincial government and/or its constituent departments from time to time, in the Republic of South Africa and/or its assigns (**Third Party**) and who wish to make an application for finance to the Bank, hereby provide the consents and confirmations to the Bank, as set out in this document.
2. The Applicant consents to the Bank collecting its Personal Information (including information in connection with the Applicant's contractual arrangements with the Third Party and/or the Bank's business development service providers (**BDSP**) from time to time) from the Applicant, the Third Party, BDSPs from time to time and where lawful and reasonable, from public sources for credit, fraud and compliance purposes as well as the purposes set out below.
3. If the Applicant gives the Bank Personal Information about or on behalf of another person (including, but not limited to, account signatories, shareholders, Collateral Providers or proposed Collateral Providers in respect of the Applicant, principal executive officers, trustees and beneficiaries), the Applicant confirms that it is authorised to: (a) give the Bank the Personal Information; (b) consent on their behalf to the Processing of their Personal Information in accordance with this document and specifically any cross-border transfer of Personal Information into and outside the country where the Bank's products or services are provided; and (c) receive any privacy notices on their behalf.
4. The Applicant consents to the Bank Processing its Personal Information and the Personal Information of those persons in paragraph 3:
 - a. to the Third Party;
 - b. to provide products and services to the Applicant in connection with any application for finance in respect of the Applicant and any other products and services for which the Applicant may apply;
 - c. to carry out statistical and other analyses to identify potential markets and trends, evaluate and improve the Bank's business (this includes improving existing and developing new products and services);
 - d. in countries outside the country where the products or services are provided. These countries may not have the same data protection laws as the country where the products or services are provided. Where the Bank can, the Bank will ask the receiving party to agree to the Bank's privacy policies;
 - e. by sharing the Applicant's Personal Information and the Personal Information of those persons in paragraph 3 with the Bank's third-party service providers (including, but not limited to, its BDSPs from time to time) and insurers, locally and outside the country where the products or services are provided. The Bank asks people who provide services to the Bank, including its insurers, to agree to the Bank's privacy policies if they need access to any Personal Information to carry out their obligations;
 - f. within the Group.
5. Without limitation to the remainder of this document, the Applicant also consents to the Bank disclosing to:
 - a. the Third Party;
 - b. the BDSPs; and
 - c. Collateral Providers,the Applicant's Personal Information, including but not limited to information regarding the Applicant's application for finance, the status thereof, the conduct on the Applicant's accounts with the Bank and any ongoing information in connection with any agreement concluded between the Applicant and the Bank in connection with such finance.
6. The Applicant will find the Bank's Processing practices in the Group's and the Bank's privacy statements. These statements are available on the Group's websites or on request.
7. **If the Applicant is unsure about its tax or legal position because the Applicant's Personal Information is Processed in countries other than where the Applicant lives or conducts business, the Applicant should get independent advice.**
8. To the extent that the provisions of this document contradict or conflict with any other data privacy consent provided by the Applicant to the Bank in terms of the Bank's product terms and conditions, the provisions of this document shall prevail.
9. For the purpose of this document, the following terms bear the following meanings and cognate expressions will bear corresponding meanings:

- a. **Bank** means The Standard Bank of South Africa Limited (Registration Number 1962/000738/06), acting through its Personal and Business Banking Division, a public company duly incorporated with limited liability according to the company laws of the Republic of South Africa and/or its successors in title or assigns;
- b. **Applicant** means the person whose name appears in paragraph 1 above;
- c. **Collateral Provider** means any person and/or entity that is to provide any security, indemnity or undertaking to the Bank to secure the Applicant's payment and other obligations to the Bank;
- d. **Group** means Standard Bank Group Limited, its subsidiaries and their subsidiaries;
- e. **Personal Information** means information about an identifiable, natural person and where applicable, a juristic person, including, but not limited to information about: race; gender; sex; pregnancy; marital status; nationality; ethnic or social origin; colour; sexual orientation; age; physical or mental health; well-being; disability; religion; conscience; belief; culture; language; birth; education; medical, financial, criminal or employment history; any identifying number, symbol, e-mail, postal or physical address, telephone number; location; any online identifier; any other particular assignment of the person; biometric information; personal opinions, views or preferences of the person or the views or opinions of another individual about the person; correspondence sent by the person that is implicitly or explicitly of a private or confidential nature or further correspondence that would reveal the contents of the original correspondence; and the name of the person if it appears with other personal information relating to the person or if the disclosure of the name itself would reveal information about the person; and
- f. **Process** means any operation or activity, automated or not, concerning Personal Information, including: alteration, blocking, collation, collection, consultation, degradation, destruction, dissemination by means of transmission, distribution or making available in any other form, erasure, linking, merging, organisation, receipt, recording, retrieval, storage, updating, modification, or the use of information; **Processing** and **Processed** will have a similar meaning.
